## **PROPOSED RULES:**

Subchapter 7. Permits for Minor Facilities Part 1. General Provisions 252:100-7-1.1. [AMENDED] 252:100-7-60.7. [NEW]

# **SUMMARY:**

The Department is proposing to amend OAC 252:100-7, Permits for Minor Facilities, by adding a new Permit By Rule (PBR) for facilities whose only obligation to obtain a permit is due to the presence of a gasoline dispensing facility or gasoline dispensing facility with an emergency engine that is subject to a federal standard. The Department is also proposing to add a definition in 252:100-7-1.1 for gasoline dispensing facilities. The gist of this rule change is to simplify the permitting process and reduce the regulatory burden for owners and operators of gasoline dispensing facilities or gasoline dispensing facilities with emergency engines.

The Air Quality Advisory Council hearing shall also serve as the public hearing to receive comments on the proposed revisions to the State Implementation Plan (SIP) under the requirements of 40 CFR Section 51.102 and 27A O.S. Section 2-5-107(6)(c); to the State Title V (Part 70) Implementation Plan under the requirements of 40 CFR Part 70 and 27A O.S. Section 2-5-112(B)(9); and to the MSW Landfills State Plan under the requirements of the CAA, Section 111(d) and 27A O.S. Section 2-5-105.
