AERCCR Mail-Back for MEDION

Welcome to the Medion mail-back program provided by AERCCR. AERCCR will ensure recycling and disposal are performed in an environmentally sound manner that complies with all governmental laws and regulations.

Medion and its partner AERCCR are not responsible for information left on equipment returned through the mail-back program and will not be able to return any equipment once you have handed it over to a collector or transporter used for the purpose of returning your equipment through the mail-back program.

Medion recommends that prior to returning equipment for recycling that consumers back up or transfer any data on the hard drive or other storage devices and then delete any data on the drives and devices.

The Medion mail-back program for consumers is currently available in the following states:

- Maryland
- Michigan
- Oklahoma
- Texas
- Virginia
- West Virginia

Important: For the purposes of this mail-back recycling program, cracked or broken monitor screens or any product showing visible leakage cannot be accepted for shipment. Contact your local municipal hazardous waste facility for proper handling and disposal of such products.

About Medion:

For over twenty years, Medion has delivered high quality technology with exceptional value. A European leader in multimedia PCs and consumer electronics, Medion has partnered with major retailers to bring its robust, reliable, and cost-effective products to the United States. Incorporated in 2001, Medion USA, Inc. is a wholly owned subsidiary of Medion AG.

Medion is committed to following the Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recycling Act. All Medion manufactured covered devices are labeled with the Medion brand. This label is permanently affixed and readily visible. Medion has a free recycling program for Medion consumers covering all Medion branded products in certain states. The details of the program are explained below.

Recycling Plan Details:

Medion's recycling program can be accessed at <http://www.medionusa.com/company/> and by clicking on 'Environmental' menu. Medion offers a convenient mail-back program to provide free recycling of Medion branded products for consumers in certain states including Oklahoma. The program covers Medion branded desktop and notebook computers and computer monitors.

Medion has partnered with AERCCR, Inc. to offer this program. Consumers can access the Medion webpage at <http://www.medionusa.com/company/> and click on the menu "Environmental" to acquire general information on the mail-back program and click on the

Medion Recycling Mail-Back link, which leads them to the AERCCR website, where they have to enter information about their location and equipment. Based on this information, a free shipping label is generated and sent to the consumer, which the consumer can utilize to ship their used Medion product for free recycling to AERCCR. Consumers merely pack the product and ship it using the free shipping label. AERCCR will ensure the products are responsibly recycled.

Below is an outline of the Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act, Section 5 C, D, E, F, and G, and a description of how Medion's program meets those specific requirements:

Section 5 C. The recovery plan shall fully explain how the manufacturer will collect from a consumer and recover each covered devices that is labeled with the manufacturer's brand, at no charge to the consumer. The manufacturer's recovery plan under this subsection may use existing collection and consolidation infrastructure for handling covered devices and may include electronic recycling and repair shops, recyclers of other commodities, reuse organizations, nonprofit corporations, retailers, recyclers, or other suitable operations.

The Medion program, as described above, provides free recycling for all Medion branded covered devices. The program provides free shipping and recycling to consumers.

Section 5 D. The recovery plan shall provide for covered device collection services that are reasonably convenient and available, and designed to meet the collection needs of consumers in this state. Nonexclusive examples of collection methods that alone or in combination meet the convenience requirements of this section include:

1. A mail-back system, at no cost to the consumer, whereby the consumer can return a covered device through the mail, including, but not limited to, a system in which the consumer can go online, print a prepaid shipping label, package the product, and schedule an at home pickup for shipment back to the manufacturer.

Medion's recycling program is a mail-back system offering prepaid shipping labels at no cost to the consumer.

Section 5E. If a manufacture does not offer a mail-back system, it shall submit for approval...

Not applicable, Medion is offering a mail-back system.

Section 5F. The recovery plan shall also include a statement that the manufacturer will not dispose of covered devices in landfills or transfer covered devices to computer equipment recycling facilities that dispose of covered devices in landfills other than necessary incidental disposal in de minimis amounts.


Covered devices recovered through Medion's recycling program are not disposed in landfills or transferred to computer equipment recycling facilities that dispose covered devices in landfills other than necessary incidental disposal in de minimis amounts.

Section 5G. Each manufacturer operating or publishing a web site for providing product information about a covered device shall include information about collection and recovery for consumers and provide such information to the Department. The manufacturer shall also include such information in the packaging or accompanying the sale of the covered device.
