Below you will find information with regard to Hannspree's Take-Back program. We are currently in negotiations with URT (Universal Recycling Technologies) in an effort to streamline our recycling program by having one centralized recycler available in all states where we are a registered manufacturer.

Attached you will find a spreadsheet of our 2009 national sales figures based on units sold and pounds sold for Monitors and Notebooks. To confirm, as I understand Oklahoma law, we are not required to recycle TVs in the state of Oklahoma. If this is incorrect, please advise and I will forward those figures to you as well, and adjust our 'take-back' wording appropriately. We have determined that the following formula gives us a fairly accurate poundage figure for individual states. By taking the 2009 census figures nationally and dividing the Oklahoma population we come up with an Oklahoma percentage of 1.20%. Taking the total amount of pounds sold in 2009 of 11,226,000 and multiplying that by 1.20% we come up with an Oklahoma portion of 134,821 pounds sold for 2009.

The following is a description of our 'take-back' program:

Hannspree North America, Inc. has an available take-back recycling program for its customers. This program is free and is available exclusively to consumers and home business owners in the State of Oklahoma.

Once we determine that the item to be recycled is our product, we will send shipping boxes and labels to the customer to have the item sent to an approved Oklahoma recycler. We encourage our customers to recycle their electronic devices purchased from Hannspree, Hanns-G or I-Inc. by placing the following information on our website:

The Oklahoma E-Waste program for Manufacturers, Oklahoma Code 1631, was signed into law and went into effect on January 1, 2009. The law requires manufacturers to provide Oklahoma household consumers with free and reasonably convenient collection, re-use and recycling opportunities for certain devices. The program will accept the following device from household consumers, covered under the Oklahoma law:

- Monitors
- Notebook computers/Netbooks

Should you have any questions or need additional information, please do not hesitate to contact. Please confirm that our registration is complete/accepted and I will be sure to mark our calendar as to the March 1st due date of the annual report due the state.

Note: Hannspree will not dispose of covered devices in a landfill or transfer covered devices to computer equipment recycling facilities that dispose of covered devices in landfills other than necessary incidental disposal in minimum amounts.
