Systech Environmental Corporation (Systech) is submitting the enclosed RCRA Part B permit application for approval to construct facilities to allow for the receipt, storage and blending of Fuel Quality Waste (FQW) prior to combustion in the two existing Lafarge Building Materials, Inc. cement kilns at the Tulsa, Oklahoma, 2609 North 145th East Ave., Tulsa, OK in Rogers County. The FQW will be stored in two storage tanks in addition to the provision of a storage area for two FQW tankers and several drums of site-generated hazardous waste. The FQW blending facility will be owned and operated by Systech Environmental Corporation and will be co-located on the Lafarge cement plant property. Lafarge is submitting a separate RCRA Part B application for their combustion activities.

Three copies of the application are included, one with an original signature. Each copy also includes a complete electronic version of the application on compact disk. A check for \$5,000 to cover the permitting fees is included.

Systech maintains an independent board of directors. Systech provides alternate fuel and raw materials to Lafarge under a contract. Systech will supply Fuel Quality Waste to the co-located cement manufacturing operation that is owned by Lafarge Building Materials, Inc., an indirectly wholly owned subsidiary of Lafarge North America, Inc. Systech began sourcing FQW for Lafarge in 1979 prior to Systech's acquisition by Lafarge in 1986.




