Proposed changes to Chapter 515 Management of Solid Waste.** The Department is proposing to amend OAC 252:515, Subchapter 21, because of recent statutory changes to the Oklahoma Used Tire Recycling Act, 27A O.S. § 2-11-401 et seq. The changes to Subchapter 21 include changing “waste tire” to “used tire”, increasing the percentage requirement for the cleanup of tire dumps, identifying how the Department will allocate funds for tire dump remediation, and making minor changes to the requirements for mobile operations. In addition, the proposed amendments afford eligibility to tires used on implements of husbandry and agricultural equipment that are not more than fourteen (14) inches wide and forty-four (44) inches in diameter. The Department is also proposing to change all references from “waste tire” to “used tire” throughout all of Chapter 515.
