Ms. Elder provided an update on Senate Bill 1938 and asked Mr. Gary Collins, Division Director of ECLS, to provide an overview of the rules that would be necessary to implemented. He provided a draft of the rulemaking and explained the requirements. He and staff responded to comments and questions from the Commission and the public. Ms. Elder added that other opportunities for public comments are scheduled and noted that written comments could be sent to her.
