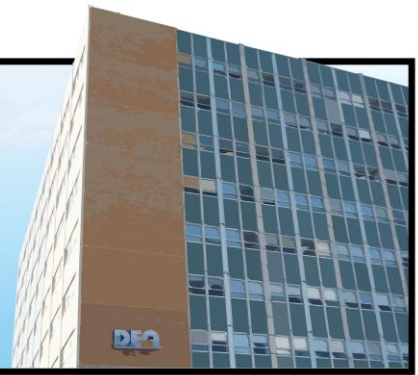

Visible Emissions Evaluation Training (Smoke School)
