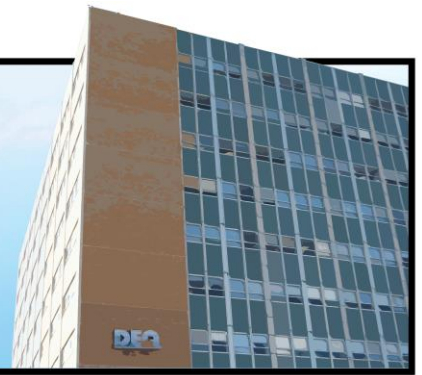

● Sponsored by: DEQ ● Topic(s): The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality is proposing to update our Incorporation by Reference, revoke some obsolete rules, and provide a budgetary update to the council.

Rule Title: IBR. **Rule Cite:** 252:205-3-1,2,& 4. **Brief**

Description: Incorporation by reference-- done annually to ensure that state rules are equivalent to federal rules. This IBR includes the revisions to the generator rules and requires updates to three sections of part 3 of Subchapter 3.

Rule Title: IBR. **Rule Cite:** 252:205-13-1. **Brief Description:** an amendment required to update the Subchapter to ensure equivalency related to the IBR.

Rule Title: IBR. **Rule Cite:** 252:205-15-2. **Brief Description:** an amendment required to update the Subchapter to ensure equivalency related to the IBR.

Rule Title: Subchapter 17. ● Sponsored by: DEQ ● Topic(s): **Rule Title:** Permits for Minor Facilities. **Rule Cite:** OAC 252:100-7. **Brief Description:** The Department is proposing to amend OAC 252:100-7, Permits for Minor Facilities, by adding a new Permit By Rule (PBR) as new section 252:100-7-60.7 for facilities whose only obligation to obtain a permit is due to the presence of a gasoline dispensing facility or gasoline dispensing facility

with an emergency engine that is subject to a federal standard; to add a definition in 252:100-7-1.1 for gasoline dispensing facilities; and to amend section 252:100-7-2 to exempt from permit requirements, gasoline dispensing facilities with less than 100,000 gallons of monthly throughput.

Rule Title: Permits for Part 70 Sources and Major New Source Review (NSR) Sources. **Rule Cite:** OAC 252:100-8. **Brief Description:** The Department is proposing to amend OAC 252:100-8-35 to remove or revise date references to reflect EPA's most current regulations.

Rule Title: Incorporation By Reference. **Rule Cite:** OAC 252:100-2, and Appendix Q. **Brief Description:** The Department is proposing the annual update to OAC 252:100, Appendix Q, Incorporation by Reference.
