Pursuant to the Section 1511 Transparency and Oversight Certification for recovery projects as required by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), enclosed is the State of Oklahoma's certification that the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund ("DWSRF") Projects have received the full review and vetting required by law and are an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars. This Certification is provided for the attached list of DWSRF Recovery Projects only and is for the December 2009 project list.

The projects are proposed to be financed with a combination of ARRA funding in the form of principal forgiveness and traditional DWSRF loan funds. The final financing and ARRA participation levels have been determined to be 30% principal forgiveness from ARRA and 70% loan from the traditional DWSRF program is anticipated.


**CERTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 1511 OF
