## ENGINEERING PLANNING & DESIGN GRANT

The Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) Program implemented a new Engineering Planning and Design Grant Program for drinking water projects in Oklahoma. Approximately \$2,000,000 has been made available from funds provided by EPA, with a maximum grant of \$125,000 per awardee. This grant program is only eligible for small drinking water systems serving populations less than 10,000, and is meant to assist in complying with the requirements of the Safe Drinking Water Act. Priority points are given for violations of maximum allowable contaminant levels (primary standards) and recommended maximum levels (secondary standards) set for drinking water. Other considerations are capacity and construction deficiencies, as well as existing compliance orders.



The Program is set up in three phases:

Phase I Scoping Report: a brief description of the water system, its deficiencies, and a list of alternatives and costs;

Phase II Engineering Report: following DEQ-approved studies, tests, analyses, etc.; and

Phase III Final Plans and Specifications. All three phases must be completed

within one year of the date the Agreement is signed by the DEQ and applicant.

Applications are good for one year; if not awarded a grant during that year, an applicant may reapply. If not awarded during one quarter, the project will stay on the priority list and be re-ranked at the end of the next quarter, and again for remaining quarters.

In coordination with the approval of the engineering report by DEQ, it is expected that funds for the bidding, contract administration, and construction portion of the project will be sought out as soon as possible. Projects may be funded through any State or Federal source, including DWSRF, Rural Development, Department of Commerce, Rural Economic Action Plan, Indian Health Service, or local funding.


## WRITTEN EXAM SESSIONS

Written exam sessions begin at 8:30 a.m. Exam applications can be printed from the DEQ website, [www.deq.state.ok.us](http://www.deq.state.ok.us). They are also available from the Operator Certification Section at (405) 702-8100. Please be sure to use the current exam application (rev 10-2009). **PLEASE WRITE LEGIBLY.** Any combination of two D and/or C exams may be taken at the same exam session. All exam applications must be postmarked three weeks before the exam session. The nonrefundable and nontransferable application fee (\$62 per exam) must be mailed with your application. Exams can be rescheduled within 120 days; however, all fees are forfeited if an exam is not taken within 120 days. ## **ONLINE EXAM SESSIONS**

The online exams are scheduled to take place directly after most regularly scheduled training classes. In order to take an online exam the student must complete the entire training class that is associated with that exam. As soon as each individual completes the exam, he or she will be able to view and print the results. All students should contact the training facility/sponsor to confirm that an online exam will take place after the class. The requirements necessary to be approved for the online exam are the same as for the written exams: an exam application must be completed and mailed with the application fee (\$62 per exam) to the DEQ three weeks prior to the exam date.

**OPERATOR LICENSES MUST BE RENEWED**  
**BY JUNE 30, 2010**

- A minimum of four hours of DEQ approved training taken between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010 is required to renew. All training listed in this newsletter is DEQ approved training that can be used for renewal, including standard classes (D through A). Be sure to call the class sponsor and make arrangements if you want to attend four hours of a standard class.
