Dear Melissa Adler-McKibben:

As you requested, below is Office Depot's Recovery Plan for the State of Oklahoma.

Collection

Office Depot will collect all Ativa® computer monitors at no charge to the consumer at all store locations in the State of Oklahoma during regular store business hours.

Beginning April 10, 2011, customers will be informed at the time of purchase that their new Ativa® computer monitor can be returned to the store for free recycling.

Disposal Statement

Office Depot will not dispose of covered devices in landfills or transfer covered devices to computer equipment recycling facilities that dispose of covered devices in landfills other than necessary incidental disposal in *de minimis* amounts.
