Dear Ms. Adler-McKibben,

Ematic is pleased to submit our Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Plan. This plan follows the Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Plan Guide as published on the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality Website.

Ematic currently operates an equipment recovery program that meets the requirement of the Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act. Ematic has a take back program that offers the consumer thru Ematic website. If and when the consumer has an Ematic product that they wish to recycle, the consumer can go to the website and complete the form. The consumer will have to enter the product information into the web based tool, including their address. A pre-paid mailing label will be sent via email so consumer can package and mail back the product. Since, the program is web based, it is convenient for the consumer to recycle the covered device. Consumer goes online, give the model information and address, print a prepaid label, and package the product then ship the product back to the manufacturer at no charge to the consumer. This program meets the collection needs of consumers of the state of Oklahoma.


