RE: Notice of Industrial Radiography Exam Application fee increase for Fiscal Year 2019

Effective July 1, 2018, the application fees associated with the Industrial Radiography Certification Exam in Oklahoma will be increased to \$149.32. The amount of the increase is 2.1%, which equals the annual rise in the U.S. Department of Labor Consumer Price Index. This includes initial, renewal and re-examination of the exam. The fee for replacement cards will be increased to \$21.33.

The application fee increase is authorized in Oklahoma's Radiation Management Rules, OAC 252:410-7-3(a)(5), in order to assist the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) in meeting rising costs of environmental services and regulatory programs associated with licensing radioactive materials usage.
