**Public Meeting Date Changed to Monday November 2, 2009
For the Draft Bacteria TMDL for the North Canadian River in
the Oklahoma City Metropolitan Area**

The meeting originally scheduled for October 1st is cancelled.

A public meeting that was scheduled for Thursday, October 1, 2009, at 6:30 p.m. has been rescheduled for Monday, November 2, 2009, at 6:30 p.m. The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality is holding the meeting at its Oklahoma City office, located at 707 N. Robinson, to receive comments on a document aimed at improving water quality in the North Canadian River as it flows through the Oklahoma City metro area.

All comments for the record must be submitted either in writing or email before the end of the public comment period on November 2nd or orally at the public meeting. DEQ will prepare a response to all formal comments received.
